ORDINANCE NO.: 6 of 2012

AN ORDINANCE OF UPPER BERN TOWNSHIP, BERKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA,
EXTENDING THE NO PARKING/RED ZONE AREA ALONG MAIN STREET (OLD
ROUTE 22) IN THE VILLAGE OF SHARTLESVILLE, UPPER BERN TOWNSHIP,
BERKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, IN THE AREA OF THE SHARTLESVILLE FIRE
COMPANY.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED, by the Board of Supervisors of Upper Bern Township, Berks County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

Section 1: No Parking Zone. In order to provide a sufficient area for the Shartlesville Fire Company and its response unit, the Upper Bern Township Board of Supervisors hereby extends the red zone/no parking area in front of the Shartlesville Fire Company by an additional thirty-five (35') feet to the corner of 4th Street and Main Street (Old Route 22) to the point of the existing yellow zone. This area shall be designated a red zone and marked as such, and no parking shall be permitted in said red zone.

Section 2: Penalties. Any person violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall, upon summary conviction before a District Magistrate, be sentenced to pay a fine of not less than Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) and not more than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) and the cost of prosecution, such fines to be collected as like fines are now collected by law, and in default shall undergo imprisonment not exceed thirty (30) days.

Section 3: Repealer. All Ordinances or Resolutions, or parts of Ordinances or Resolutions, insofar as they are inconsistent herewith, shall be and the same are hereby repealed.


Section 4: Validity. If any section or part of a section of this Ordinance shall be declared invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the remaining parts or sections of this Ordinance. It is hereby declared to be the legislative intent that this Ordinance would have been enacted as if such invalid section, or portion thereof, had not been included therein.


Section 5: Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective five (5) days after enactment thereof.




